Introduction

The office of the Executive Engineer, Rengali Right Canal Division No.I, Khuntuni came into being vide Department of Water Resources Letter No.9675 dated 26.4.2016 after renaming of Rengali Right Canal Division No.I, Baghuaboli, Talcher and now functioning in the premises of the office of the Chief Construction Engineer, Rengali Right Irrigation Project, Mahisapat, Dist.Dhenkanal since dated 1.7.2016.

This office has been assigned with the execution of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910km to RD 33.477Km and all its distribution systems in between Darpani Branch Canal is one of the branch canals of Rengali Right Bank Canal. The main objective of Darpani Branch Canal is to provide irrigation of 50907 ha, in 5 Blocks and 3 Districts of Odisha like, Dhenkanal, Cuttack & Jajpur districts. This division is covering part of Dhenkanal and Cuttack districts only.

Salient features of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910Km to RD 33.477 Km.

1. Length of Darpani Branch Canal = 14.537 Km.
2. Length of Distributary(1 no) = 9.415 Km.
3. Total length of minors/subminors(6 nos+17 nos) = 44.205 Km.

The Designed ayacut of Darpani Branch Canal under the jurisdiction of this division is 4152.31 Hqs.

Activities.

This Division was assigned with survey and land acquisition work for the execution of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910Km to RD 33.447Km and its distribution systems. This Division came into act on 1st July,2016 and took over the charges of the newly established Division and started its job for survey and land acquisition of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910Km to RD 27.520Km and one minor with two sub-minors in five nos of village like, Siaria, Gobindapur, Barbanka, Mahulpada and Sahardahikore in Dhenkanal district. The activities are as follows :

Within this small span of period, this division has processed the land acquisition work up to 19-1 stage. The balance land acquisition work are in process. On the other hand one cross drainage work at RD 23.945Km of Darpani Branch Canal crossing Badajore Nallah near Joranda Road Rly. Station, Dhenkanal has been considered to be taken up for which tender process has been completed this year for an amount of Rs.12,27,79,765.00. The said work will be taken-up in the year 2017-18.

Darpani Branch Canal in between its reach of RD 18.910Km to RD 33.447Km is crossing National Highway No.55 at RD 21.915Km and Naraj-Rajthagarh Rly. Line at Rd 32.352Km. It is a great success that for the Railway crossing processing has been done with E.Co. Railway authorities, and as per estimates, detail drawings and approval of Department of Water Resources, Govt. of Odisha an amount of Rs.15,09,01,088.00 has been deposited with Railway authorities on 31st January,2017 as deposit work. The Railway authority will take up the work immediately. Regarding N.H. crossing, the NHAI, Dhenkanal has been moved and the same will be materialized very soon.

For execution of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910km to RD 33.477km estimates are in process from RD 18.910Km to RD 27.520km and the tender process will be completed by october,2017. The balance portion of Darpani Branch Canal from RD27.520Km to RD 33.4770Km is coming under Reserve Forest(Patapuri/Ranibania&Deulia R/F) hence no work could be taken up till clearance from Forest Department.
