INTRODUCTION

The office of the Executive Engineer, Rengali Right Canal Division No.I, Khuntuni came into functioning after renaming of Rengali Right Canal Division No. I, Baghuabol, Talcher vide Department of Water Resources Letter No. 9675 dated 26.04.2016. Now the Division is functioning in the premises of office of the Chief Construction Engineer, Rengali Right Irrigation Project, Mahisapat, Dist. Dhenkanal since 01.07.2016.

This office has been assigned with the execution of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910 Km. ;to RD 33.477 Km, and RD 74.290 Km. to 84.095 Km. with all its distribution systems in between Darpani Branch Canal is one of the Branch Canals of Rengali Right Bank Canal. The main objective of Darpani Branch Canal is to provide irrigation of 50,907 ha in 5 Blocks and 3 Districts of Odisha i.e. Dhenkanal, Cuttack and Jajpur districts. This division is covering part of Dhenkanal, Jajpur and Cuttack districts only.

Salient features of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910 Km to RD 33.477 Km. & RD 74.290 Km. to 84.095 Km.

1. Length of Darpani Branch Canal - $14.537 \text{ Km.} + 9.805 = 24.342 \text{ Km.}$
2. Length of Distributary (2 Nos.) = $9.415 \text{ Km} + 13.361 \text{ Km} = 22.776 \text{ Km.}$
3. Total length of Minors / Sub-Minors (6 Nos. + 17 Nos.) = 44.205 Nos.

The Designed ayacut of Darpani Branch under the jurisdiction of this division is $4152.31 \text{ Ha} + 8934.36 \text{ Ha} = 13,086.67 \text{ Ha.}$

Activities

This Division came into function on 1st July, 2016 and assigned with survey and land acquisition works for execution of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.91 Km. To 33.447 Km. and its distribution systems. Accordingly this Division has started survey and land acquisition work of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910 Km. to RD 27.520 Km. and one minor with two sub-minors in five nos of villages like, Siaria, Gobindapur, Barbanka, Mahulpada and Sahardahikore in Dhenkanal district and from RD 74.290 Km. to 84.095 of Darpani Branch Canal and one distributary in seven villages like Bandhapalli, Rajihar, Samia, Champapur, Gohirdal, Badasal and Khankira in Jajpur district.

Within this short period, this Division has processed the land acquisition works upto 19-1 stage and 50% payment of Gobindapur village has been made. The balance land acquisition works are in process as mentioned in above table. On the other hand one cross drainage work at RD 23.945 Km. of Darpani Branch Canal Crossing on Badjore Nallah near Joranda Road Rly. Station, Dhenkanal has been taken up for which tender process completed and the work has been awarded to Sri L.R. Makkar, Spl. Class Contractor for an amount of Rs.12,27,79,765.00. The work is under progress and the agency has executed 30.27% of work.

Darpani Branch Canal and Gundichapada distributary will cross NH-55 at RD Km. 35.650 and at Km. 32.407 Chainage. In this connection Project Director, NHAI, Dhenkanal and R.O., NHAI, Bhubaneswar have been moved and they have approved for signing of agreement after depositing the required Way Leave Charges and Supervision Charges before execution of the canal crossing structures.

Regarding Railway Crossings of Darpani Branch Canal, as it is a deposited work, the estimated amount of Rs. 15.09 Crore has been deposited with Railway Authority and the work has been started.

For execution of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 18.910 Km. to Rd 33.477 Km., estimates are in process for RD 18.910 Km. to RD 27.520 Km. and tender process will be completed by October, 2018 after possession of 80% required land. The balance portion of Darpani Branch Canal from RD 27.520 Km. to RD 33.477 Km. is coming under Reserve Forest (Patapuri / Ranibania, Godabala and Deulia reserve forest). Forest Clearance Proposals have been submitted to MOEF&CC through Department of Forest and Environment, Govt. of Odisha with all the compliances sought for.
