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GENERAL INTRODUCTION

River Brahmani is the 2nd largest River of Orissa having its catchment area of 37545 Sq km. The river originates from the state of Jharkhand and Chhatisgarh having catchment of 15440.62 Sq km. and 1364.16 Sq km. respectively in the name of two tributaries named as “Sankh” and “Koel”. After confluence of “Sankha” and “Koel”, it is named as “Brahmani” and flows through district of Sundargarh, Deogarh, Angul, Dhenkanal and Jajpur in the state of Orissa, for a length of 455 km. The River again bi-furcated in two rivers namely Kharsuan & Brahmani near Patia i.e. Jenapur Railway Bridge and the branch Kharsuan again re-joins the river Brahmani after a travel of 85 km., thus creating a doab in between. During flood, prior to Rengali Dam the entire Brahmani deltaic region was remaining submerged causing devastation. Thus Rengali Dam was envisaged as a Flood Control, Power Generation and Irrigation Project. In the 1st stage development, construction of Rengali Dam and Power House was commenced in the year 1972 and completed in the year 1985 including construction of a Barrage at 35 km. downstream at Samal Barrage. Since completion of Rengali Multipurpose Project, it has been successfully controlling the flood in Brahmani delta covering an area of 2600 sq.km and Generating Power from the installed capacity of 250 MW (5x50 MW).

OVERVIEW OF BASIN

The Brahmani and Baitarni basin is the 17th largest basin having total catchment area of 51907.45 Sq.km which is nearly 1.7% of the total geographical area of the country. The basin spreads from 83°55' to 87°3' east longitudes and 20°28' to 23°38' north latitudes on Indian sub-continent. The basin is bounded by the Chhotnagpur Plateau on the north, by the ridge separating it from Mahanadi basin on the west and the south and by the Bay of Bengal on the east. The maximum length and width of the basin is 403 km and 193 km.

The basin is further divided into two sub-basins namely Brahmani and Baitarni. The Brahmani sub basin covers 37,545 Sq.km and has a long sausage shape.

The catchment area of basin consisting of Brahmani Rivers extends over states of Odisha, Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh. Major portion of its catchment lies in the state of Odisha and Jharkhand and very small in Chhattisgarh.

JURISDICTION

Rengali Dam Division is consists of three Sub-Divisions Namely: -

1. Rengali Dam Sub-Division No-I
2. Rengali Dam Sub-Division No-II
3. Rengali Dam Sub-Division No-III

A. RENGALI DAM SUB-DIVISION NO-I

Rengali Dam Sub-Division No-I is consists of two Sections. These two sections looks after the works of flood control, Data recording like reservoir level, rainfall, periphery work, rehabilitation work etc.

B. RENGALI DAM SUB-DIVISION NO-II

Rengali Dam Sub-Division No-II is consists of four Sections. These four sections looks after the works of Internal Road maintenance work, Building maintenance work (Residential & Non-Residential), water supply to colony and mainly Dam maintenance work

C. RENGALI DAM SUB-DIVISION NO-III

After re-structuring of Division and staffs Electrical Sub-Division and D & G Sub-Division are merged in Rengali Dam Sub-Division No-III which looks after the works of Electrical maintenance of Dam, Colony and Non-residential building, Repair maintenance of vehicles, watch and ward of Central Store. Mainly it looks after the dewatering of foundation gallery of Rengali Dam.
