**RESOLUTION**

**SUBJECT—**Reconstitution of Dam Safety Review Panel (D.S.R.P.) for Safety Review of Large Dams in Orissa.

The safety of the large dams in the State is the vital component under Dam Safety Assurance & Rehabilitation Project. The Dams require adequate investigation, Design, Planning, Construction and Hydrological Survey frequently for proper functioning.

2. In order to arrange safety review of large dams in the State, Government have been pleased to reconstitute the Dam Safety Review Panel (D.S.R.P) with the following Members :—

3. The Panel will have the following functions :—

- It will examine and review the adequacy of investigation, design and hydrology.
- It shall suggest remedial measures to ensure safety of the structures.
- It will inspect dam sites, review the distress condition and suggest necessary remedial measures.

4. The Panel will meet frequently to assess the status of the dams and to present recommendation.

5. The Chairman and the members of the Panel shall be paid a consultancy fee of Rs. 5,000 (Rupees five thousand) only per day plus transportation facilities for their journey. For their halt, Department may arrange IBs./Guest House, etc. If they stay in Hotel, the Department may reimburse the actual cost subject to maximum of Rs. 750 per day.

6. All other Orders/Resolutions issued in this effect stand superseded.

7. This has been concurred in by Finance Department UOR No. 1460-PSF., dated the 30th April 2010.
