 - (iii) Facilitate inter-agency, co-ordination and co-operation during FMIS development.
 - (iv) Encourage active association and collaboration of National entities involved in Flood management.
 - (v) Review the annual action plan and activity report of the FMIS Cell.
 - (vi) After reviewing the findings of FMIS Cell, recommend any structural or non-structural measures to be taken up for approval of State Flood Control Board.
3. (i) The Advisory Committee-FMIS will meet in each quarter starting September, 2007.
- (ii) The Member Convener will convene the meeting on a suitable date as approved by Chairman.
