RESOLUTION

The 15th March 2013

SUBJECT—Constitution of 2nd Dam Safety Review Panel (D.S.R.P.) for safety review of large Dams in Odisha.

The Dam Safety Review Panel (DSRP) review of DRIP included dams have been made mandatory by the World Bank and the Central Project Management Unit (CPMU). As DRIP is a time bound project of six years duration starting from April 2012 and the proposed remedial measures of the project included dams are to be vetted by DSRP, the other participating States have either formed or contemplating to form more than one DSRP to finalize the remedial actions to the dams expeditiously. This proposal has already been agreed upon in the first meeting of the Technical Committee in New Delhi held during June, 2012.

2. Now, it is felt that in Odisha there is the need of constituting another DSRP for expeditious completions of the review of balance 34 dams out of total 38 numbers of dams under DRIP. Keeping in view the aforementioned facts into consideration, Government have been pleased to constitute a 2nd Dam Safety Review Panel with the following Members :—

1. Shri Ashok Kumar Ganju, Former Member (D&R), CWC as Chairman
2. Shri Sudhakar Patri, Former C.E., W.R., Government of Odisha as Member
3. Shri Nrusingh Charan Mohanty, Former C.E., W.R., Government of Odisha as Member.
4. Shri Padmalochan Mohapatra, Former S.E. (Mech.), W.R., Government of Odisha as Member.

3. The Panel will have the following functions :—

- (i). It will examine and review the adequacy of investigation, design and hydrology.
- (ii). It shall suggest remedial measures to ensure safety of the Structures.
- (iii). It will inspect dam sites, review the distress condition and suggest necessary remedial measures.

4. The Panel will meet frequently to assess the status of the dams and to present recommendation.

5. The Chairman and the members of the panel shall be paid a consultancy fee of Rs. 5,000 (Rupees five thousand) only per day plus transportation facilities of their journey. For their halt, Department may arrange IBs/Guest Houses etc. and if IBs/Guest Houses etc. are not available, Department may book hotel rooms. DOWR will make payment as per actual hotel accommodation cost limiting to maximum of Rs. 5,000 (Rupees five thousand) only per person per day. No amount will be paid to the panel Members towards cost of accommodation.

6. At a particular time, if required, authority can pull members from either of the existing panel depending on their requirement and availability irrespective of their panel combination for inspection of a particular dam.

ORDER—Ordered that the Resolution be published in an extraordinary issue of *Odisha Gazette* and copies thereof be forwarded to all Departments of Government/all Heads of Department/Chairman and Members of the Panel.
