

PROCEEDINGS OF THE REVIEW MEETING OF PLAN EXPENDITURE , MONITORING & EVALUATION (PHYSICAL & FINANCIAL) OF MAJOR, MEDIUM, FLOOD CONTROL & DRAINAGE, MINOR & LIFT, CAD AND WALMI IRRIGATION SECTORS OF DoWR UP TO THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2017 HELD ON 06.03.2017 AT 10.00 A.M IN THE RAJIV BHAWAN CONFERENCE HALL.

Principal Secretary to Government presided over the meeting.
List of participants is at annexure-I.

Principal Secretary expressed his deep sorrow and regret for the unfortunate accident that took place in the morning at Bagh Barrage site. One minute silence was observed as a condolence to the workers who lost their lives in that accident. He highlighted the significance of maintaining safety measures at work sites and in water. He expressed his happiness that almost all EEs have already kept life jackets which is a non-negotiable necessity. Now helmets are also to be made available for CEs, SEs, EEs, JEs and workers at sites. Some helmets are also to be kept for visiting officers. These helmets should bear Govt. of Odisha logo on the front, DoWR printed on both the sides and helmets should be of different colours (white for officers, blue for Engineers, yellow/ orange for workers). Along with that all at the site must use full shoes instead of chappals. All should practice practicing safety measures so that SEs, EEs, AEs, JEs and workers would observe every month should be observed as a Safety Day where safety points should be discussed highlighting their necessity for our family and ourselves. EIC-cum-Special Secretary will issue a circular in this regard.

He reviewed the plan expenditure status up to the month of February of each CE against the target committed and observed that the target set in toto had not been achieved.

Following instructions were given

- all to take all possible steps for full utilization of fund. (CEs/ CCEs/ Addl. Director, CAD)
- Sri B.B.Dash, FA-cum-Joint Secretary and EIC, WR to pursue Finance Department for sanction of re-appropriation proposals. (Sri B.B.Dash, FA-cum-Joint Secretary and EIC, WR)
- all to never compromise with quality. (CEs/ CCEs/ Addl. Director, CAD)
- all CEs/CCEs to bring all types of indiscipline and unruly behavior of staffs so that action could be taken against them. (CEs/ CCEs)

- M.D., OCC to settle the ongoing issues on admixture being used in Ret and Tele projects. (M.D., OCC)
- sort out the problem persisting in Padmapur village under Anandpur Barga Project (CCE, ABP)
- submit a compiled report on work in hand, work in tender stage etc. prior to the next Plan Review meeting. (CEs/ CCEs/ Addl. Director, CAD)
- submit Action Plan for the Financial Year 2017-18 and 50% of the Budget Provision to be utilized during the 1st quarter (April - June). (CEs/ CCEs/ Addl. Director, CAD)

Sri Santh Gopalan, Special Secretary opined that nodal officers for each district should be finalized who would monitor the integrated action plan of Major & Medium, M.I, L.I. and Mega lift Projects in the irrigation deficit blocks of each district. EIC, WR intimated that the names of nodal officers had already been finalized and submitted that list in the meeting. (Annexure-III).

It was decided that the nodal officers would meet every month to review their activities and the proceedings of that meeting would be submitted to EIC-cum-Special Secretary for further discussion in the next Plan Review meeting. (All Nodal Officers/ CEs/CCEs)


- Annual Health Report of different Basins would be prepared and hoisted in the website like previous year. (CEs/CCEs)
- 50 working divisions would be audited by one Senior Officer (CE or SE) and the audit report would focus on list of all works done in the last three years, work advance, tender procedure, approval of work programme and reason for taking up work of small nature amount in that. This audit would start from April. (CEs/CCEs)
- EIC, WR requested all CEs to submit details of proposals submitted for repair of minors and sub-minors under NREGS against the target of Rs.5.00 crore each. The concerned CEs would certify for the cases where fund is not required under NREGS. (CEs/CCEs)
- Sri Santh Gopalan, Special Secretary intimated that there is a procedure to apply for fund under NREGS. Dharamgarh division has successfully done that. So a model of that division should be circulated among all divisions to follow it. (EIC, WR)
- A Power Point Presentation was made by Sri N.R.Swain, F.A.-cum-Joint Secretary on pending position of C & AG para, Controlling Officer-wise ATNs & UCs. All Controlling

officers were instructed to submit compliance and furnish UCs in time. (All Controlling Officers)

The CE/CCE-wise statement of committed expenditure for March 2017 is enclosed in the Annexure-II.

The list of Nodal Officers for furnishing information relating to blocks having irrigation potential less than 35 % is enclosed in Annexure-III.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
