PROCEEDINGS OF THE REVIEW MEETING ON FLOOD PREPAREDNESS FOR THE ENSUING RAINY SEASON OF 2018 OF DoWR HELD ON 06.04.2018 AT 10.00 A.M IN THE RAJIV BHAWAN CONFERENCE HALL.

Principal Secretary to Government presided over the meeting.

List of participants is at annexure-I.

At the outset Principal Secretary recapitulated the preparatory steps taken in the last two rainy seasons to deal with flood. He instructed to CE, Flood Control to initiate all flood preparedness activities immediately.


The points given below are to be followed strictly:

- EIC, WR would declare Verification of embankment days and get it approved from the Collector by 10th April'2018.
- He should declare 15th-21st April as Embankment Verification week.
- All concerned EEs would prepare day-wise plan and get it approved from the Collector and submit it to the higher authorities. The concerned SEs should monitor the execution of that plan every day and submit report to EIC,WR and CE, Flood Control.
- Verification of embankment has to be done in the following manner
 - (a) 100% verification by the JEs.
 - (b) 50% verification by EEs.
 - (c) 25% verification by SEs and
 - (d) Verification of critical and vulnerable embankments by CE.
- There should be wide publicity of the verification of embankment activities. The BDOs/Tahasildars/Sarpanches/P.S. members/Zilla Parishad members should be intimated about the verification immediately after the finalization of programme. Wherever possible detailed programme would be sent through e mail. The verification report duly approved by the concerned Collector should be submitted by the end of April'2018.

- Mock drill of all types of mechanical gates should be undertaken without fail. Collector should be intimated about each such drill so that he could be present in some places during the drill. Mock drills should be complete by 15th of May.
- There should be proper assessment of flood fighting materials like empty cement bags, sand, bullah and bamboos be kept at strategic locations in time.
- Location-wise detail storage of flood fighting materials should be hoisted in the DoWR web site for public awareness. EIC,WR would look after this matter.
- EIC, WR should take initiatives in the 1st week of June through announcement to make the public aware of flood and warn them to stay away from river to avoid mishaps.
- Similarly, announcements should be made through fax, e mail, TV, Panchayat Office, Executive Offices, ULBs and loudspeakers (within 10 kms) sufficiently ahead of release of flood water. Flood water should be released only after verification and approval of the check list by the CE.
- JEs/AEEs/EEs/Dy. EEs should prepare a pocket diary containing the contact numbers of Collector, SP, BDOs, Tahasildar's, SDVO's, Sarpanch and Panchayat Officers and keep with them so that in case of breach they can be intimated immediately. The occurrence of breach should also be put in what's app for intimation. SEs should ensure this.
- The presence of EEs, SEs and CE at the breach sites would give assurance to the public which would refrain them from panic. So their presence is vital at the site during such period. Personal rapport of EEs with the public would play a great role in building faith & confidence during crisis
- All officers should be present at their respective Headquarters from 1st June to 30th November, 2018 and would leave only after sanction of leave and availability of alternative arrangement.
- EIC,WR, CEs and RDCs have already been intimated about large scale sand mining activities at river beds. As Impact Assessment Officers, EEs could assess on technical basis the suitable quantity & place for lifting sands.

- Illegal sand lifting activities must be taken to the notice of the Collector as it weakens the river bed and flood embankments making it valuable for breach etc.
- Plying of heavy vehicles for sand lifting also damages the health of the Embankments. That needs regular monitoring and reporting to the concerned Collector.
- The Department of Works & RD should be intimated to take prior permission of DoWR before constructing bridges over rivers & nallahs. Steps should be taken to form a committee with EIC, WR, EIC, P&D, CE, Planning, CE, Design, CE, Flood Control and the concerned Basin Manager as members which would examine and provide NOC to the above said Departments on certain conditions.
- Sri Satrughna Das, Consultant Advisor, Flood Control requested all to give emphasis to identification & closing of piping points noticed during rainy season and clearance of jungles from the embankment slopes. Contact numbers of all concerned should be available with SE,FC, CE,FC,EIC,WR and DoWR.
- As officers might change from time to time training is essential to make them aware of types of problems arise during flood. Sri Satrughna Das, Consultant Advisor, Flood Control would prepare a training module & select 8-10 Officers who could prepare a booklet on training and could also impart training. There should also be an Orientation Programme for Dy.EEs/ EEs and SEs. CE,FC would submit an Annual Training Calendar every year.
- Sri K.L. ^{Mishra} ~~Saranghi~~, Addl. Secretary to Govt. explained the significance of meticulous preparation of Disaster Management Planning.









