(S)-6/09 19479 WR/ Whereas the State Government propose under sub-section 3 of Section 5 of Orissa Irrigation Act, 1959 to [construct/extend/improve the] Irrigation work known as the **Ghatakeswar Multipurpose Project** a description of which is hereby given in the schedule hereto annexed notice is hereby given that –

- (i) any person whose lands are likely to be affected by the proposed work or who is otherwise interested may present in writing any objection to or suggestion in respect of the proposed work in duplicate so as to reach the Collector, Ganjam on or before 29.08.2009.
- (ii) Objections and suggestions received will be kept open for inspection of the public in the office of the **Collector, Ganjam** for a period of 15 days following the last date of receiving objections or suggestions as mentioned above.
- (iii) Objections presented under clause (i) shall be heard at **11.30 AM** on the 14.09.2009 at **Court Hall of Collector, Ganjam, Chatrapur.**

SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT WORK

1. Name of the work : Ghatakeswar Multipurpose work.
2. General description of the project : Illustrated in Index Map pasted on the notice boards of the office of the Collector, Ganjam, Sub-Collector, Berhampur, BDO, Kukudakhandi and Kankia Gram Panchayat.

(Plans and descriptive notes can be seen in the office of the **Collector Ganjam**, from 30.07.2009 to 29.08.2009 on any working day during office hours).

Ghatakeswar Multipurpose Project has been proposed to provide multipurpose benefits

such as irrigation facility to 500 Ha. of land in Kukuhandi Block of Ganjam district and drinking water facility to Sub-urban areas of Berhampur e.g Gosaninuagoan and near by rural areas. This project is aimed to provide Class-I Irrigation facility to 8 nos of villages through a canal system of about 10 Km long . Water will be stored in the catchment/basin of river Ghadaka. At about 5 Km down stream of the Damsite a diversion weir will be constructed across river Ghadaka at Village Rampalli . The canal system off taking from diversion weir at left side will irrigate around 500Ha. A pipe line from the reservoir will supply water @ 0.10 cumecs for drinking water purpose to a population of 75,000 in sub-urban areas of Berhampur town and near by rural areas.

4. Necessity on the purpose of the work

: To provide 1st class irrigation facility to economically backward and poor cultivators affected by frequent drought during khariff and to provide drinking water facility to sub-urban areas of Berhampur town in Ganjam District @ 0.10 cumecs daily to a population of about 75,000.

: 500 Ha (CCA) and 875 Ha (GCA)

In respect of new irrigation works compulsory basic water rate will be levied for the 1st time and the following principle shall be adopted.

- In the 1st year when water is left out in aycut: Nil
- In the 2nd year when the water is left out=50% of the approximate rate.
- In the 3rd year when water is left out=75% of the approximate rate.
- In the 4th year and thereafter per year=100% of the approximate rate.
