

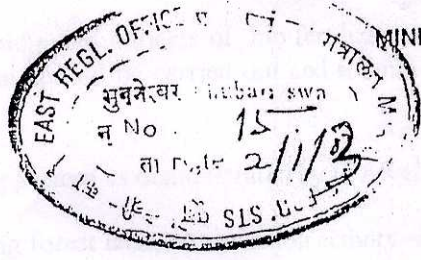

Subject:- Extension of Left and Right Canal System of Upper Indravati Irrigation Project in Orissa – Environmental Clearance - Reg.

Sir,

Please refer to your letters requesting for environmental clearance for the above referred project.

2. The above referred proposal was considered by the Expert Committee for River Valley & Hydroelectric projects at its meeting held on 21.7.2000 and 5.3.2002. The project located in Kalahandi District of Orissa envisages extension of Left and Right Bank Canal of Upper Indravati Multi-purpose project to provide irrigation to 45,794 ha of land in Kalahandi District Orissa. The extension of the right canal by a length of 29 Kms will irrigate CCA of 15,260 ha in Bhawanipatna sub division of Kalahandi District. In addition, a provision of 1 Cumec of drinking water supply has been made for Bhawanipatna town. Extension of left bank canal with a length of 31.1 Kms will irrigate CCA of 10 224 ha in three blocks of Kalahandi District. The project is estimated to cost Rs.136.67 crores at 1997-98 prices.

3. The Environment Management Plan submitted has been examined. The Ministry of Environment and Forests hereby accords environmental clearance as per the provisions of Environmental Impact Assessment Notification, 1994, subject to strict compliance of the terms and conditions as follows.

Part-A: Specific Conditions

(i) A Monitoring Committee should be constituted to oversee the implementation of environmental safeguards for the project satisfactorily. Experts from fields of Botany, Crop Science, Malaria Prevention and Ground Water should be included in the Monitoring Committee.

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- (ii) Flow rate in the canal system will not be less than 0.5 m/s to avoid incidence of malaria.
- (iii) A study on the anticipated impacts of bio fertilizers and a comprehensive study on the preservation of bio habitat should be carried out and submitted to this Ministry within six months.
- (iv) Scientific cropping pattern as demonstrated by ICAR should be followed.
- (v) In stretches involving forest land, construction activity should not be taken up without obtaining clearance under the F.C. Act.

#### Part -B: General Conditions

- i) Adequate free fuel arrangement should be made for the labour force engaged in the construction work at project cost so that indiscriminate felling of trees is prevented.
  - ii) Fuel depot may be opened at the site to provide the fuel (kerosene / wood / LPG). Medical facilities as well as recreational facilities should also be provided to the labourers.
  - iii) All the labourers to be engaged for construction works should be thoroughly examined by health personnel and adequately treated before issuing them work permit.
  - iv) Restoration of construction area including dumping site of excavated materials should be ensured by leveling, filling up of burrow pits, landscaping etc. The area should be properly afforested with suitable plantation.
  - v) A multidisciplinary committee should be constituted with representative from various disciplines of forestry, ecology, wildlife, soil conservation, NGO etc. to oversee the effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures.
  - vi) Financial provision should be made in the total budget of the project for implementation of the above suggested safeguard measures.
  - vii) Six monthly monitoring reports should be submitted to the Ministry and its Regional Office, Bhubaneswar for review.
4. Officials from Regional Office MOEF, Bhubaneswar who would be monitoring the implementation of environmental safeguards should be given full cooperation, facilities and documents / data by the project proponents during their inspection.
5. The responsibility of implementation of environmental safeguards rests fully with the Government of Orissa.
